Lead Liberated convenes principals of color, their supervisors and their Instructional Leadership teams for collective learning over the course of two years. We support leaders of color to heal from racism while learning technical and adaptive skills to develop antiracist learning cultures in their schools.

The Antiracist Collective is for principals of color in Bay Area, CA who

- have a Preliminary Administrative Services Credential (PASC) & passed the CalAPAs.
- have yet to earn their Clear **Administrative Services Credential, &**
- want to engage in their own healing and development within a community as they begin their principalship.

Through our alliance with <u>Reach University</u>, principals will earn their Clear Administrative Services Credential.

Principals will pay \$4500 each year to clear their administrative credential through Reach for two years. The remaining costs for coaching and professional development are supported through philanthropic funds.



As an Antiracist Collective Principal you will receive:

- a comprehensive school review to gather baseline data and support your leadership priorities,
- biweekly 1:1 coaching anchored in observations of learning and ILT meetings,
- professional development with your cohort,
- job-embedded assignments that will support your growth and development as an antiracist instructional leader, and
- support from an amazing network of Alumni.
